## Bulgaria - GOD AT WORK AMONG THE ROMA GYPSIES

In September, we spent two weeks in Bulgaria with our family, Craig, Milena and our granddaughters Gillian and Tegan. We had gone to be with our family and to see the work that God is doing among them. We thought we might have a couple of weeks of hot sunshine after the dreadful UK summer, however, after three days the temperature dropped and on went the woolies!

Craig and Milena work with six Roma Gypsy Churches, they lead a Church for Bulgarian people and also the Jutvari Football team, trained by Segun. We shared at some of the churches, attended part of a weekend conference led by Tim Grant from Aldershot, and cheered on the football teams as they won one game and lost another.



One evening in Saidenenie, we shared in a meeting in one church led by Sashco, and heard this amazing testimony. It was of a lady who had been prayed for in one of Tim Grant's meetings just days before. A few months earlier, this lady had been working in Cyprus where she received a very powerful and damaging electric shock, which had paralysed and badly burnt her arm. However, as we were praising God in the meeting at Saidenenie, the healing was manifested and she suddenly burst out with an amazing testimony of healing as she waived her healed arm in the air, and leaped around with great joy and thanksgiving.
