

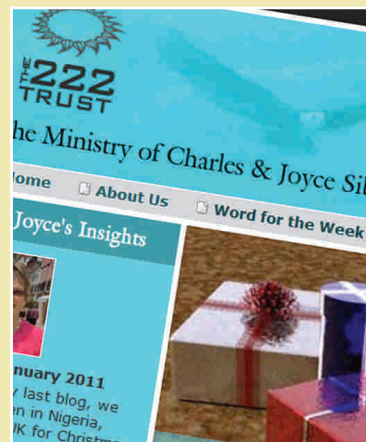
WORD FOR THE WEEK
