



Africa 2009

In February, our visit to Africa began on the island of Zanzibar – we joined Ben, Anne and their four children who were taking a well earned break from their work with Mission Aviation Fellowship in Chad. We stayed in a couple of cottages and were only ten minutes from an idyllic tropical beach. We were able to be with the family for nine days, whom we had joined particularly to support Anne with the four children while Ben spent 5 days at the MAF Engineers Conference in Nairobi. It was a fantastic break, we loved spending time with the family and strengthening our relationships with our grandchildren.

We then flew on to Burundi to be with Chrissie and her team, to listen and to encourage. The sixty orphan children who live in the CRIB house are growing, developing and maturing, which is exciting and challenging. The Kings School, with more than 250 students is the main School in Bujumbura educating in English, they are always over subscribed as more and more children want places.

We were also able to participate in the special days of Prayer and Fasting that take place each month in the Eglise Vivante at Jabe. Several thousand gathered each night for worship, prayer and teaching. We brought teaching on "Christ in You" and were amazed at the response. Every week they see new people coming to faith in Jesus and on the Sunday we were there more than 50 responded to the invitation. We then flew to Rwanda, and spoke in the Church in Kigali and were able to spend some quality time with Edmond Kivuye who heads up the work of African Revival Ministries.



This August, six young folk from Living Waters Church are going to Bujumbura, Burundi to run a Holiday Club for the CRIB children, and to experience first hand what God is doing in this formerly war torn nation. Chris and Clare Wilkinson will lead the team, each member of which has been responsible to pray in and work to get the money to go. There are wonderful stories coming through of the way God is providing, and some are still trusting God to provide the remaining cash needed. Chris leads our Missions Support Team, and Clare is our Children's and Youth Co-ordinator.
